

second wife Simone Dunoyer. The biography claims that the information that Naval was related to the founder by blood relationship

emerged while examining certain historical records in the custody of Parsi priests in Navsari, Gujarat. Naval was adopted by Navaibai Tata, after the passing away of her husband Sir Ratan Tata, the second son of Tata Group founder Jamsetji. It also so happened that Naval's mother Ratanbai was the favourite cousin of Navajbai's late husband, Ratanbai was the daughter of Cooverbai, sister of Jamsetji Tata's wife.
